Colin Dunne will return to Berlin to teach a weekend course in Traditional Irish Step Dance.

All classes will be taught in heavy shoe technique. Colin's classes focus on the release of unnecessary tension in the body, the art of listening, and finding joy and pleasure in movement that makes sound. With the focus being solely on heavy shoe, dancers will develop their skills in timing, rhythm, musicality, speed, and complexity.

There are two levels of classes to choose from. Below is a guide:

Level I

Level I is most suited to primary and early intermediate dancers who are still learning how to dance simple combinations of steps in time to music. In this class, you will be working with more basic movements and rhythms in order to create a solid technical foundation. This level is also beneficial for more advanced dancers who would like to take the time to revisit their underlying technique, and for dancers who are interested in teaching.

Level II

Level II is suited for late intermediate and advanced dancers who are already able to dance comfortably in time to music. You will be working with more complex movements and rhythmical patterns and developing a greater awareness of musicality, flow, and style. In these classes, you will also be learning how to "dance the tune", by working with specific patterns of steps that interpret melody in addition to the underlying rhythm of a piece of music.

Please note! Dancers should consider which level they are best suited to, to gain the most benefit from the workshop. If after the first class, Colin feels that a dancer should change level for the second day, he will advise you.

Improvisation for Traditional Irish Dancers

This class will introduce the practice of rhythmical improvisation in heavy shoe. Colin will lead you through a series of exercises and tasks and you will begin to create your own unique movement and rhythmical patterns to music, instantaneously. Improvisation allows you to explore creative possibilities with your technique.

This class is only recommended for dancers who have a good understanding of and technical proficiency in timing.

Terms & Conditions for the Colin Dunne Masterclasses

1. The deadline for applications is the 1st of February 2023.
2. Deadline for Early Bird Discount is the 15th of January 2023.
3. After we received your application form, we will inform you about your Fee that is to be paid within 5 days via bank transfer into our account (Gyula Glaser-Ohnesorge; IBAN: DE67 1001 1001 2626 9528 02; BIC: NTSBDEB1XXX). After we received your Fee, you will receive a Confirmation Email about your successful application.
4. Please note that a confirmed application **can be cancelled at no cost only till the 1st February 2023**. After this date, only 50% of your fee can be refunded.
5. Please note that classes have a maximum capacity of 15 participants. The improvisation class is limited to 12 participants. In case of larger interest, we will create a waiting list, or look for a larger venue, but we cannot guarantee.
6. Single Class Admissions (for example you only would like to apply for 1 class on Saturday) will only be confirmed upon availability after the 1st of February 2023. The Improvisation Class is exempt from this regulation.
7. Everyone is attending the Colin Dunne Masterclasses on their own responsibility. The Teachers and Organizers are not taking any responsibility for injuries. For attendees under age 18, a legal representative of the child also must sign the printed application form.
8. Minimum age for participants is 12.
